

# Episode 16 - REINCARNATED

*Act 1: Burt begins to receive notes from Xavier leading him to solve a mystery, but the more clues Burt gets the more lost he becomes. **The fish confront Burt for being disassociated from current events** in the tank. Jobe gets closer to Mizzy.*

*Act 2: While the fish struggle with Frank, **Burt is whisked away to the Schitty**. The fish deal with brutal situations in the house while Burt experiences a fantasy with Xavier. Burt has a revelation that he has been letting his friends down and decides to become Gold Burt, and tell Frank to leave his friends alone.*

*Act 3: Burt stands up to Frank, and **Frank breaks up with Burt, brutally**. Jeff is tasked with making Jobe quit, and Jobe, inspired by Frank, counterattacks until Jeff breaks. The fish are unable to handle Frank any longer, so they pay him to leave the house.*

## Act 1

Burt sits down to burt off but Mizzy is sent to bring him downstairs and he cusses her out. ("I'm burting off! God!") Goldstriker apologizes from downstairs and allows him to finish. In the den, the fish demonstrate their lack of skill in pull-ups. Goldstriker advises them that they should improve or they will face elimination. (All details including teams are unnecessary).

Under the cover of a Ball Bros. concert, Burt receives a TTS directing him to the Yard - the audience can see the TTS has been sent from Xavier Ravenblood.

**Note: "Yusuf I don't know what they do with the letters we send. They reconstructed my childhood bedroom."**

**Xavier: Do you remember the code words, "Grimace Avalanche Yearning," what does that spell? "Gay?"**

The fish notice that Burt is stumbling around wearing his costume wig and Jeff pretties him up. While Burt is chasing a red herring that leads him to disembowel plushies, Xavier hits him up again.

**Xavier: I can see you are yearning for truth. Go to b3 and look at your white fan for the truth. Go now.**

**Xavier: What does MDE stand for? Male dating espionage? Correct, Male dating espionage is the true code word. You are getting closer to the truth.**

Burt tries to take the fan from bedroom 3 and Simbal warns him not to take it. Burt takes it anyway, and brings it to the jacuzzi room and smashes it apart. TTS decodes the letter he finds inside it for him.

**Note: Haqre gur punve va pbasrffvbany** ("Under the chair in confessions")

Burt can't find the note there, and assumes someone has sabotaged him.

Mizzy is put in the locker room to assemble a sandbox as “punishment,” although Goldstriker does not remember what she is being punished for (not contributing to the triathlon). Jobe hangs out with her while she is stuck in there. Frank throws her stuff out of her bag while she is not there to guard it.

Nifty is brought in while Mizzy gathers her scattered possessions. Her introduction is interrupted by Mizzy shouting at Frank for tossing her stuff around. The fish are asked to air out their feelings about the show but the fish rapidly divert into complaining about Burt. The fish complain that Burt is siding with Frank and not paying attention to the game or what is going on around him. Simbal accuses Burt of “hiding in the penthouse and talking to TTS while wearing a wig and walking around with a sword and shield for no reason. Where are the fucking dragons?” Burt accuses them of jealousy and says that Mizzy is doing secret things to control the show, and calls Mizzy Regina George. His accusations become increasingly nonsensical until he accuses them of all being actors. Burt accuses Mizzy of lying about her age and she says he is bugging out about irrelevant shit and screams “who gives a fuck?!” They both raise their voices as Burt accuses Mizzy of knowing more than she lets on, as she explains nothing that he is worried about has any meaning. Burt gets a fishtoy from “Do Not Trust Mizzy,” which he takes to Jeff as damning evidence, but Jeff spits on it and throws it out.

Still livid, Burt stumbles out into the Den where Ben and Jet are doing Ball Bros. again.

## Act 2

Frank throws a drink at Mizzy and hits Payton in the eye. Simbal steps in, saying he can’t do that to a 19-year-old girl. In bedroom 3, Simbal charges Frank and tries to punch him in the back of the head until Vance throws him to the ground. Production takes Simbal’s whip away so he threatens to stab Frank with some glass at the island and production takes it from him. They continue to wrestle in the den.

Completely disinterested in the fighting, Burt receives another note (don’t know where) and reads it in the penthouse.

**Note: Hello Burt after following my clues so diligently, I suppose I should give you a name to call me, so you can call me X.**

Frank tells Burt that X told him he will be “taken to another house soon.” Frank goes downstairs to harass Payton, and Jeff shouts “it’s funny till it ain’t fuckin funny, dude.” They wrestle and Payton punches the shit out of Frank.

Burt is picked up by a golf cart, and in the schitty, Burt meets Xavier. Usable audio is iffy, but the important gist is that Burt becomes convinced that Alex has not left the property and has been “reincarnated” as Xavier and that they have been reunited. Xavier becomes frustrated that Burt isn’t really able to follow the clues as intended.

When Burt goes to bed, Jet and Ben tell him a bedtime story. Within 30 seconds of them leaving the room. Burt begins jerking off and production can be heard in the basement screaming in terror.

Burt meets with Binx and Frank in the penthouse and says that because Binx's hair is blue, and he has been told to look in the blue plushies, she is fated to be in an alliance with him. She returns to her room and finds a note there among her plushies.

Frank pushes Burt to rob Binx's suitcase, but she distracts him by inviting him to read the note she found earlier.

**Note: You'll be the new Luca, and Luca will become Lucas. You could've been the one holding the camera if you'd just stayed.**

TTS tells Burt in the penthouse that the show is a personality remodeling program that recreates people to become better. Burt comes to a realization that he hurt his friends and begins to cry, and announces his goal is to become Gold Burtstriker.

## Act 3

Burt apologizes to the others in bedroom 3, and says he wants to stop betraying his friends to work with Frank.

In the penthouse, Burt tries to ask Frank to leave politely. Frank announces he wasn't gay after all anyway, and is actually repulsed by all the gay things that Burt does, and says that watching Burt sniffing his shoe was one of the worst things he's ever seen in his life. He pursues Burt to his inflatable mattress, where Goldstriker stabs it and leaves Burt to slowly sink into it while sobbing. Burt agrees to box Frank over it and is comically bad at fighting but "wins." Burt insists this means that Frank must leave, but Goldstriker tells him that isn't the case and that Burt doesn't have a moral leg over Frank either because he betrayed all his friends for hypergay shit.

Jeff is nearly unconscious in the kitchen and production takes turns trying to wake him up.

*Confessional: Jet and Goldstriker ask Jeff what the worst thing he's ever done is and he says he sold fent to a police officer. They task him with messing with Jobe.*

In bedroom 2, Jobe tries to hassle Jeff, but Frank repeatedly gets between him and Jeff for his own safety, with Frank often lifting and saving Jobe like a little kitten. In the morning, Jeff gets into a verbal conflict with Jeff and tries to convince Burt to help him throw Jeff out, but Burt is distracted by Nifty's positive sentiments towards Jeff and ends up scolding Jobe for saying the n-word. Frank pours cigarette water on Jeff and he whips a pot at him. Luca sits Jeff down in bedroom 3 and says "sticks and stones may break my bones but..." and Jeff finishes "I'll still smash ya in the fuckin' mouth."

Burt is put on the case again once the drunks are calmed down.

**TTS: I told you the answer already you dumb motherfucker. Under the couch in confessional. Sweetie cutie pie.**

He spends time in confessional, but can't make sense of the dossier of evidence he is given and should be shown getting increasingly distracted by explanations that don't make sense, like Frank being from the 70s, and people being cloned, until he starts trying to cast magic spells.

While Burt wrestles with Frank again, Goldstriker asks the fish how much they would be willing to pay to kick Frank out of the house. Payton and Burt agree to pay everything they have. Goldstriker announces that Frank is leaving and asks the fish to say goodbye to him, and on Frank's way down the stairs Burt hurries after him to give one private goodbye.
